After being laid off from his job of many years, Eddie Herrera went to WorkSource, Sunnyside and sought out the staff who had supported him. He expressed his gratitude for the assistance that he had received from the People For People UI Navigator program. Eddie shared that the support he received from the UI Navigator, Marty Garibay, helped him manage his emotional turmoil of being laid off and provided the needed guidance on navigating the UI process. Despite facing multiple delays and fact-finding steps, Eddie was eventually approved for UI benefits.

The UI Navigator also referred Eddie to the Dislocated Worker program where he received additional education and training support from Noelia Gonzalez. Thanks to this support, he was able to secure a better job than he had before. Eddie was so appreciative that he created a testimonial video to encourage others in similar situations.
